Stakeholders,

The City of Boise is proposing to repeal and replace the following ordinances:

- Plumbing Code
- Mechanical Code
- Fuel Gas Code

A summary of updates to the ordinances includes:

- General clean-up and formatting to ensure consistency across all three of these codes.
- Separating the Fuel Gas Code from the Mechanical Code
- Amendment of administrative provisions such as:
 - Application and Scope, Title
 - Designation of Code official and Deputies
 - Licensing aligned with State Statute
 - Permit expiration, Permit extensions
 - Permit transfer, Fee refunds
 - Penalties, Stop work orders
 - Removing fee schedules from the ordinances (these will be adopted separately under a City Master Fee Schedule)
 - Consistency in duties and procedures of the City Plumbing, Mechanical and Fuel Gas Board of Appeals

The City of Boise Plumbing, Mechanical and Fuel Gas Code Board of Appeals has reviewed the proposed updates, recommending approval to City Council.
